Understand the Last Days

"Above all" means ultimately we need to live with great conviction.

Conviction: the state of being fully persuaded by the truth resulting in an unwavering willingness to stand firm, fight, and sacrifice based on that belief.

Dear friends, this is now my second letter to you. I have written both of them as reminders to stimulate you to wholesome thinking. 21 want you to recall the words spoken in the past by the holy prophets and the command given by our Lord and Savior through your apostles. 3Above all, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires.

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

## The Last Days are Marked by Rejecting God as Creator

They will replace the power and authority of the creator with science.

- 1. Evolution
- 2. Big Bang
- 3. String Theory
- 4. Dark Matter

EVOLUTION: The world is a purposeless creation, created by purposeless eternal material

CREATION: God is the first cause and He created a purposeful world

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10

BIG BANG: the beginning of the universe started with an unexplainable explosion

CREATION: God's all powerful creative voice began the universe

And God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light.

Genesis 1:3

"Because the law of gravity and the quantum vacuum exist, therefore, the universe will create itself from nothing."

-Stephen Hawking

Translated into a simpler, logical format:

"Because something and something else exists, therefore, some other thing will create itself from nothing."

STRING THEORY: The essence of the universe began with the sound through unseen vibrating particles of strings

CREATION: Divine vocal chords produced energy that created the universe

The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word.

Hebrews 1:3

DARK MATTER: A non-theistic, powerful, mysterious, eternal, first-cause with the capacity to create life, order and sustain all things

CREATION: "Mysterium Tremendum" is what the world calls dark matter, and that is God

He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.
