Dysfunction Can Be Defined By Three Things:

- 1. Avoidance: Satan's poison gas
- 2. Blame: Satan's relationship grenade
- 3. Shutdown: Satan's cut-off strategy



Loving Those Closest to You Is a God Moment

Love Defined:

Love is the ability to impart spiritual, emotional and physical nourishment to others which highlights **their** value and **our** commitment.



The Spirit gives love for On-the-Spot Intimacy that really sets people free!

Loving those who are far and not loving those who are closest to you is still dysfunctional!

The Holy Spirit is the power and impulse behind those moments.
